2. Students with a grade of "A" in ENGL 1301, ENGL 1302, and either ENGL 2332 or ENGL 2333 may take any 3000-level course in lieu of a second 2000-level course. Students must receive a "C" or better in all English coursework in order to apply it to any English major or minor.
