MASTER OF EDUCATION IN SCHOOL COUNSELING

The Master of Education in School Counseling is a CACREP-accredited degree designed specifically for students who want to work toward certification as a school counselor in Texas. It requires completion of forty-eight hours of graduate credit and may meet academic requirements for Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC). The program is designed to comply with existing Texas Education Agency standards for professional certification, but students are encouraged to check the state licensing rules for changes in the requirements. All students must take the comprehensive examination during Supervised Practicum (COUN 6376). Students must be enrolled in the university when taking the comprehensive examination and when applying for graduation.

 - b. one from a former professor, certified school counselor or licensed counselor, marriage and family therapist, MSW, or psychologist
 - c. one from someone other than a family member
- 9. Essay
- 10. Face-to-Face interview
- 11. Service Record (ASEP reporting) submitted through TK20
- 12. Valid Teacher Certificate (ASEP reporting) -submitted through TK20
