

MASTER OF EDUCATION IN SPECIAL EDUCATION

This 36-hour degree plan is designed for those holding a valid teaching certificate. The degree plan originates in the Department of Language, Literacy and Special Populations. The candidate must successfully complete a departmental comprehensive examination. Candidates must be enrolled in coursework during the semester they take comprehensive examinations.

To be regularly admitted to the graduate school, applicants must submit to the Office of Graduate Admissions:

5. Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended, both undergraduate and graduate (Note: A official GRE scores, if GPA in last 60 hours is below 2.75)
6. Two Recommendation Forms
7. Writing Sample
8. Copy of applicant's Teaching Certificate
9. Official GRE (<http://www.ets.org/gre>) scores, if GPA in last 60 hours is below a 2.75
10. Teacher Service Record

NOTE: Candidates may be permitted to enroll for one semester while their admission file is incomplete.

Applicants with completed files are reviewed for regular admission by graduate faculty in each program area and are selected by faculty based on information in the completed file.
