7. Official transcript from the baccalaureate degree granting institution.
8. An undergraduate degree from an accredited academic institution.
9. Candidates with a 3.0 GPA from the baccalaureate-granting institution or graduate<sup>1</sup> will have the GRE automatically waived. Candidates with an undergraduate GPA between 2.5 and 2.99 from the baccalaureate-granting institution or between 2.8 and 2.99 in graduate level hours<sup>1</sup> from the baccalaureate degree-granting institution are required to take the GRE. These candidates must meet the minimum standard with the following formula:

$(\text{GPA} \times 50) + \text{GRE Verbal} + \text{GRE Quantitative} + \text{GRE Written}$  equal to or greater than 435

### GRE TAKEN BEFORE AUGUST 2011

$(\text{GPA} \times 200) + \text{GRE Verbal} + \text{GRE Quantitative} + \text{GRE Written}$  equal to or greater than 1664

<sup>1</sup> If a student has taken graduate level coursework after receiving their Bachelor's, but has not received a Master's degree, then those hours become void and are not taken into consideration.
