

# PERCUSSION (PERC)

**PERC 1101. Secondary Performances-Percussion. 1 Hour.**

Students study techniques and musicality related to percussion in weekly individualized private instruction. Students admitted as a Percussion primary are not permitted to take this course.

**Prerequisite:** Must be a music major with a different applied instrument concentration, or by instructor permission.

**PERC 1201. Individual Performances-Percussion. 2 Hours.**

The course consists of individualized private instruction in percussion. Instruction focuses on technique and musicality. Students also attend a weekly studio class, where there are opportunities to perform for fellow students.

**Prerequisite:** Students must have instructor permission.

**PERC 3201. Individual Performances-Percussion. 2 Hours.**

The course consists of advanced individualized private instruction in percussion. Instruction focuses on technique and musicality. Students also attend a weekly studio class, where there are opportunities to perform for fellow students.

**Prerequisite:** Students must have passed a sophomore proficiency jury.

**PERC 3202. Applied Percussion w/ Jr Recital. 2 Hours.**

The course consists of advanced individualized private instruction in percussion. Instruction focuses on technique and musicality. Students also attend a weekly studio class, where there are opportunities to perform for fellow students, and perform a culminating recital.

**Prerequisite:** Students must have instructor permission.
