

# BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION - MAJOR IN ACCOUNTING

The Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) degree consists of the University Core Curriculum ([catalog.shsu.edu/archives/2016-2017/undergraduate/academic-policies-procedures/degree-requirements-academic-guidelines/core-curriculum](http://catalog.shsu.edu/archives/2016-2017/undergraduate/academic-policies-procedures/degree-requirements-academic-guidelines/core-curriculum)), the Business Core ([catalog.shsu.edu/archives/2016-2017/undergraduate/colleges-academic-departments/business-administration/#businessscore](http://catalog.shsu.edu/archives/2016-2017/undergraduate/colleges-academic-departments/business-administration/#businessscore)), courses required for the major, degree-specific requirements, and electives.

Note: Transfer students must take at least 50% of the required business curriculum for the BBA degree in residence at Sam Houston State University.

## Program-Specific Requirements

### Minimum GPA Requirement for a BBA in Accounting

A cumulative (SHSU and transfer) minimum GPA of 2.5 is required for students to graduate with a BBA in Accounting.

### Minimum Grades in Accounting Courses

Accounting majors must make a minimum grade of "C" or better in all accounting (ACCT) courses taken to graduate with a BBA in Accounting.
