Students will also gain insights into ethical and legal considerations in taxation, as well as the implications of tax policies on business decisions and the economy. The twenty-one (21) hour Minor in Taxation is available to all bachelor's degree programs that permit a minor. The Minor in Taxation requires the following courses with a minimum grade point average of 2.0, both in residence at SHSU and overall (SHSU and transfer combined).
